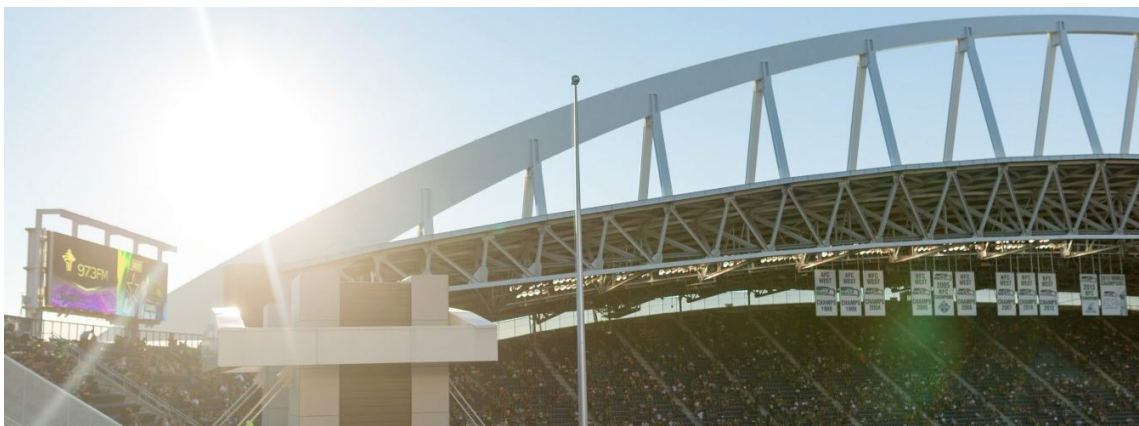




Stadium Guide

FAN CODE OF CONDUCT

CenturyLink Field management is committed to creating a safe, comfortable and enjoyable experience for its guests. The staff will proactively intervene to support an environment where event patrons, their guests and other fans can enjoy the event experience free from the following behaviors:

- Behavior that is unruly, disruptive or illegal in nature
- Over-intoxication or other signs of alcohol or substance impairment
- Foul or abusive language or obscene gestures
- Interference with the progress of the game (including throwing objects onto the field)
- Failing to follow instructions of stadium personnel
- Verbal or physical harassment of home or opposing team fans
- Verbal or physical harassment of stadium guests and staff members
- Smoking, tobacco or marijuana use on CenturyLink Field property

Guests who cannot conform their conduct to these rules are not welcome at Seattle Seahawks games. Unruly or inconsiderate behavior and fighting will not be tolerated and will result in ejection from the stadium and/or permanent revocation of ticket privileges.

Each guest should be in possession of their ticket stub and be ready to display it to stadium officials to verify their seat location. All Season Ticket Holders are responsible for their own conduct as well as the conduct of their guests and/or persons occupying their seats.

As part of an NFL initiative, the Seahawks will require fans that are ejected from the stadium for violating of the Fan Code of Conduct to take a four-hour online course before they are permitted to come back into the facility. The cost of the course will be \$250.

Each guest should hold his or her ticket stub and be ready to display it to stadium officials to verify their seat location. All Ticket Holders are responsible for their conduct as well as the conduct of their Guests and/or persons occupying their seats.

**The use of streamers and confetti as an expression of fan enthusiasm during Sounders FC matches is not prohibited, but will be kept under review. Streamers are not to be used to impact the competition and/or thrown at or toward a player, referee or stadium staff member.*

CLEAR BAG POLICY

CenturyLink Field enforces measures designed to both enhance public safety and create a safe environment at CenturyLink Field and CenturyLink Field Event Center for all stadium events (including Seahawks games and Sounders FC matches). Guests of CenturyLink Field may carry only the following style and size bag, package, or container into CenturyLink Field or when approaching queue lines.

CLEAR BAGS

Bags that are clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12". (Official NFL team logo clear plastic tote bags are available through club merchandise outlets or at nflshop.com). One-gallon clear plastic freezer bags (ziploc bag or similar). No clear backpacks.

SMALL CLUTCHES/PURSES/WALLETS

Small clutch bags, that do not exceed 4.5" x 6.5", with or without a handle or strap, may be carried into the stadium along with one of the clear bag options.

MISCELLANEOUS BAGS

- Seat cushions that have no pockets, zippered compartments, or extra straps.
- Oversized bags cannot be placed in acceptable clear bags and will be denied entrance.
- Exception for medically necessary items after proper inspection at the NE VIP Gate, NW VIP Gate, SW VIP Gate, Club Entrance (Garage Level 5), Suite Entrance (Garage Level 6).
- Outside food entering CenturyLink Field must adhere to the clear bag policy and dimensions.

The following items are NOT permitted at CenturyLink Field

— Weapons

+ Outside Beverages

+ Laptop Computers

+ Cases

+ Video Recorders & Selfie Sticks

+ All Noisemakers

+ Flag Poles, Footballs & Sticks to Hold Signs

+ Motorcycle Helmets

ALLOWED ITEMS

The following items are permitted at CenturyLink Field

+ Children's Juice Boxes & Soft-Sided Single-Serving Containers

Outside Food in Clear Plastic Bags or Pizza in Pizza Boxes

ALCOHOL/ID POLICIES

CenturyLink Field works hard to promote responsible consumption of alcoholic beverages. Our alcohol policies are listed below and are also posted at every concession stand.

- Any guest who appears to be under age 30 must present a valid ID (see below).
- No alcohol will be sold to guests who are under 21 years of age.
- No alcohol will be sold to guests who appear intoxicated.
- There will be a two (2) beer / wine limit, per transaction, at concession stands and portable concessions until alcohol cut, which varies by event.
- There will be a one (1) spirit limit, per transaction, at club locations until alcohol cut, which varies by event.
- Guests passing alcohol to minors will be ejected and subject to arrest.
- Guests possessing alcohol, who do not have proof of being at least 21 years of age, may be ejected.
- We reserve the right to refuse the sale of alcohol to any guest.
- Alcoholic beverages may not be brought into CenturyLink Field. Any attempt to bring alcohol inside will be considered a violation of the Fan Code of Conduct and may result in the guest being ejected, arrested, or tickets being revoked.

Identification **MUST** be valid (not expired) and show:

- The bearer's date of birth,
- The bearer's signature (except US Military ID),
- A photograph of bearer.

— Forms of ID are that are accepted

The following forms of ID are acceptable at CenturyLink Field:

- Driver's License, Instruction Permit, or ID Card issued by any U.S. State, U.S. Territory, and District of Columbia.
- Driver's License, Instruction Permit, or ID Card issued by any Canadian Province.
- Valid Washington State Temporary Driver's License.
- US Armed Forces ID Card (encrypted signature & vertical format accepted).
- Merchant Marine ID Card issued by the U.S. Coast Guard.
- Official Passport Booklet or Official Passport Card (must be printed in bearer's native language and in English).
- NEXUS Card.
- Washington State Tribal Enrollment Card (no expiration date required).

Federal Express: With approved credit cards or a FedEx account, the Lost and Found Office can prepare items for shipment Monday – Friday before 3:30 p.m.

U.S. Mail: The Lost and Found Office can return small items via U.S. Mail, if you forward a self-stamped mailing container to the Lost and Found Office.
